COMPENSATION / MANNER OF PAYMENT

Please provide payment to GSQ after the engagement.

GSQ's compensation for an event of this type would be a stipend and or a Love Offering setup by the scheduler .

SET UP

It would be helpful if the stage could be completely cleared prior to load-in.

SOUND

The Golden State Quartet travels with their own sound equipment but are open to use the "House System".

One standard electrical outlet and a contact person who is familiar with the venue's sound, lighting and electrical setup to assist with preparations during load-in and sound check.

Sound check will be done immediately following setup. Please assist in making sure that the performance stage remains clear of anyone not directly involved with the concert's production until the official opening of doors. This will help facilitate a quick, uninterrupted and thorough setup and sound check.

HOTEL ACCOMODATIONS

If hotel accommodations are required in the performance contract, please make the reservations for two (2) rooms for a late arrival, late departure. (Some hotels offer a "day rate" that will be beneficial.) We will arrive at the hotel in the early morning hours (usually between 3 am and 9 am) the day of the concert. It is very important that they be able to check in upon arrival. Checkout will be mid-afternoon on the same day in most instances. It is very helpful if the hotel is aware of these needs in advance of arrival. The hotel you select should be in close proximity (within walking distance) to local restaurants and shopping if possible.

TAPING

Please do not allow Golden State Quartet's presentation to be recorded (audio or video) without first securing permission from our office or group members.
